The foundation for a strong hockey player is the proper learning of fundamental skills. The program is comprised of one hour sessions for one week as follows:

Hockey 1 • For players with little to no ice hockey experience. The focus is on learning basic hockey drills and skills. Completing Learn to Skate Basic 3 is recommended or equivalent skating skills.

Hockey 2 • For players who have completed Hockey 1. The emphasis is on strengthening skating skills and developing stick handling and shooting skills needed to begin game play.

Advanced Instructional • For players who have completed Hockey 2. In addition to developing further skating, stick handling and shooting skills, players are introduced to game situations preparing them for recreational or travel leagues.

Goal Tending • New! Small group goaltending instruction for entry level. Goalies will focus on proper equipment, positioning and game situations. Additional emphasis will be placed on body mechanics and conditioning. The recommendation of a coach is required.

Refunds are permitted prior to the start of a session only and are subject to a \$20 administrative fee.

Brandon LaDue Youth Hockey Program
using USA Hockey trained instructors.**

Loaner equipment will be provided if available to all participants. The program has been created to provide an inexpensive, fun, safe atmosphere for children ages 6 through 12 to learn the game of ice hockey. (Children 5 years and under are eligible if they have completed the Learn-to-Skate's Tot Program). The program is designed to help players

develop such skills as skating, passing, shooting and stick handling. Completion of the program prepares players for recreational or travel league play.
