Accessibility & Repair Program

coordinated by the Office on Aging
assists Howard County residents of varied income levels in identifying home modification needs and resources. Financial help is available for qualified homeowners.

Who is eligible?

- Homeowners 62 years of age or older (or who reside with someone 62+)
- Homeowners of any age with a disability (or who reside with someone with a disability)
- Eligible homeowners must own and occupy the dwelling in Howard County to be repaired or modified.
- Homeowners who meet income eligibility requirements.

What kind of help?

Repairs or modifications to help eliminate health, safety and property maintenance deficiencies and ensure compliance with codes and standards.

Among the repairs or modifications considered health and safety related are:

- Grab bar installation
- Plumbing repairs or replacement
- Roof repairs
- Home insulation
- Electrical system repairs
- Hot water heater repair or replacement
- Home accessibility

Through funding provided by Columbia Association, there are resources specifically available to Columbia residents.
