| <p>Glenn Gerbino and Terry Haley introduced</p> <p>Tennis Director's Report</p> | <p><u>Glenn:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Tennis Desk Team has been assembled consisting of 25 team members at 4 different clubs and 70 different shift.</li> <li>• Hobbits Glen playing condition is very good. They are receiving positive feedback. The new patio furniture and benches have been installed.</li> <li>• Poison Ivy is being treated.</li> <li>• They have adjusted the water practices that have resulted in the courts drying faster. The courts are watered more during the evening than during the day and not watered when it is going to rain.</li> <li>• They are working on securing the new benches.</li> <li>• The June Social and Nancy Stefan's Retirement Party went well and was well attended.</li> <li>• Hand dryer at Hobbits Glen needs to be fixed.</li> <li>• Water coolers are being cleaned nightly.</li> <li>• Hobbits Glen courts need to be swept and rolled by staff more.</li> <li>• A suggestion was made that the staff come out onto the courts more and check the condition of tables, bathroom, trash, etc.</li> <li>• Glenn feels very welcomed at CA.</li> </ul> <p><u>. Maury:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Court #6 at Owen Brown is now fenced in. It is to be used as a ball machine/coaching court and for 10 and under players. It is a great court for families, practice and coaching. Permanent storage for ball machine is being added.</li> <li>• 400+ high school athletes were at Wilde Lake tennis for High School Tournaments.</li> <li>• In May 2018, CA hosted the Maryland High School County Championships, the Maryland High School Regional Championships, and the Maryland High School State Championships. Twelve members made it to Regionals. One girl made it to the Final Four of the State Championships.</li> <li>• CA also hosted 50 adults for the NTRP Tournament. May also saw the Bobby Hoffman tournament and a 10 and under tournament.</li> <li>• Owen Brown has 6 new Pickle Ball courts under construction. Drop in play should begin in July.</li> <li>• Athletic Center – working on having block time start on time. 99% renewal rate for Block time. There is lots of interest in LRTC block time.</li> <li>• August 3 at Owen Brown is the date for the second Pickle Ball Certification in America.</li> </ul> <p><u>. . Anish:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Athletic Club has a dedicated landing page that displays pictures of the renovation progress.</li> <li>• Swim Center is closed for renovation.</li> <li>• Plans are in the works for Supreme Club renovation.</li> <li>• Please encourage members to complete surveys.</li> <li>• Our NPS score increased from 30 to 39. | <p>USTA League Report<br/>Liz Baker</p> <p>Janet Molleur</p> |                                   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Spring/summer numbers are up from last year.</li> <li>• Adult 18 &amp; over—75 teams vs. 72 from last year. 1213 players vs 1160.</li> <li>• Adult 40 &amp; over – 926 players vs 910. Matches are continuing but room must be made for Adult 18 and over to complete their matches first.</li> <li>• Adult 40 &amp; over MIXED – 21 teams vs 18 teams. 314 players vs 260.</li> <li>• Adult 55 and over – rainouts are not as dire a situation as other leagues since they have until mid August to complete them. Same number of teams as last year, but 334 players vs 285. Two new levels this year – 6.0W (3 teams) and 8.0W (2 teams).</li> <li>• Adult 65 and over – same number of teams. 119 players vs 99 players.</li> <li>• Adult 55 and over MIXED – we anticipate two teams at the 7.0M level.</li> <li>• Adult Mixed 18 and Over Sectionals will be held at Wilde Lake and Owen Brown. Two Howard County teams are going to Sectionals.</li> <li>• Total number of players are projected to exceed the 4276 from last year.</li> </ul> <p>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• League collection fees going well. Working with Terry to pick up where Nancy left off.</li> <li>• Have connected almost every person looking for a team with a team.</li> <li>• USTA refers player to us through TennisConnect.
