

**Golf Advisory Committee
Annual Report – FY 21 (FYE April 30, 2021)**

The members of the FY21 Golf Advisory Committee were Keith Heilveil (Committee Chair), Bill Harris (Vice-Chair), Lin Eagan (CA Board Member), Barbara Collins, Debbie Dunn, Mac Ramsey, Lew Shipp, Troy Fitzgerald, Marco Depalma, Kelli Pasqueslla, Lew Ship and Tim Cuomo. The staff liaison was Joan Lovelace. The Committee met three times during FY21.

A. Committee accomplishments for FY21 (Fiscal year just ended):

- In alignment with the CA's strategic plan and founding principles, we have added several new committee members representing a wider selection of players in our golf community.
- Improved the playability and overall experience of Fairway Hills and improved the tees at Hobbits Glen with quality and consistent turf.
- Engaged the diverse golf community to participate in various activities offered by the golf course, driving range, player development and restaurant. Due to the pandemic we were not able to fully implement our plans with regards to this goal.

B. Proposed Charge submitted for approval to the CA Board identifying items to be addressed by Committee in FY22 (Fiscal year just beginning) that align with the Committee's goals, CA's strategic plan and the President/CEO's goals and objectives:

- Increased inter-club opportunities for CA members to enjoy activities at both golf facilities.
- Focus on community outreach with emphasis on inclusion of diverse community groups.
- Improvement of short game areas at both facilities.

C. Committee recommendations, if any, with justification, for consideration by CA Board:

- Rehabilitation of the bunkers, bunker drainage, and sand replacement at Hobbit's Glen.
- Improvement of the short game practice areas, collars/fringes/rough in areas adjacent to and surrounding green complexes.
- Improvement of mulched or stepped walkways to teeing grounds to improve footing/traction, especially when descending from elevated areas.
